

FIJI'S GROSS DOMESTIC PRODUCT (GDP) 2010

GDP CURRENT PRICE

Fiji's GDP at current basic price for 2010 is provisionally estimated to grow at 7.9 per cent in 2010. This is an absolute increase of 8.8 per cent from 2009 when the growth was -0.9 per cent. Table 1 gives data on the GDP at current basic price and at market price by activity from 2005 to 2010.

GDP CONSTANT PRICE

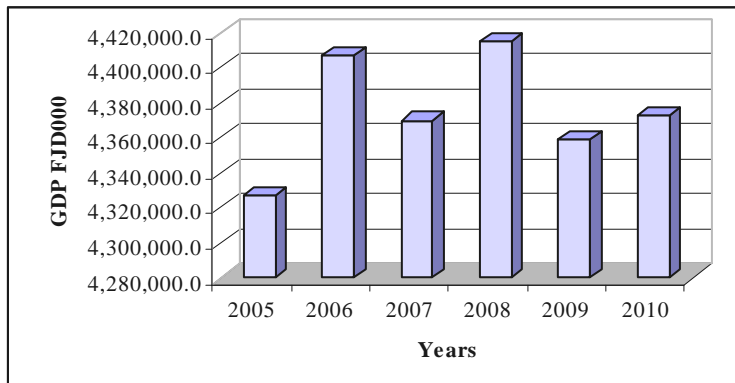
Fiji's GDP at constant prices of 2005 for 2010 is provisionally estimated to grow at 0.3 per cent in 2010. This is an absolute increase of 1.6 per cent from 2009 when the growth was -1.3 per cent. Table 2 gives data on the GDP at constant price by activity from 2005 to 2010.

Fiji's constant price GDP is provisionally estimated at \$4372.8 million for the calendar year 2010. Of this \$381.9 million or 8.7 per cent was contributed by non-monetary production; that is, from the own account activities in the agriculture, fishing and forestry and construction sectors and the notional owner occupied dwellings in the real estate sector. When compared to

2009, GDP in 2010 shows an increase of \$13.9 million. Per capita GDP at constant price for 2010 was \$5156.2 compared to \$5168.2 in 2009.

Composition of GDP

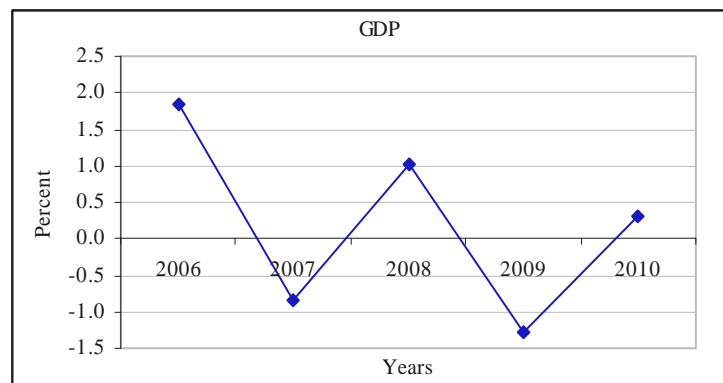
Transport Storage and Communication sector contributes most to the GDP. In 2010, it accounted for 15.6 per cent of the GDP compared to 15.7 per cent in 2009. Manufacturing sector is the second highest contributor. In 2010, it accounted for 15.0 per cent of the GDP compared to 13.6 per cent in 2009. The third highest contributor is the Wholesale and Retail sector. In both 2009 and 2010 it accounted for 11.0 per cent of the GDP. Refer to Appendix 3 for more details.

Growth in GDP

The economy grew in 2010, from a negative 1.3 per cent (-1.3%) growth in 2009 to a positive 0.3 per cent growth. Sectors contributing to the growth are:

- Forestry growing by 31.4 per cent
- Mining and Quarrying growing by 27.7 per cent.
- Electricity and Water growing by 13.8 per cent.
- Hotels and Restaurant growing by 13.0 per cent.
- Manufacturing growing by 10.7 per cent
- Construction growing by 6.8 per cent
- Financial Intermediation growing by 1.2 per cent.
- Real Estate and Business Services growing by 0.8 per cent

Sectors that registered declines are:

- Public Administration and Defence declining by 18.2 per cent
- Health and Social Work declining by 9.9 per cent.
- Agriculture declining by 9.8 per cent.
- Education declining by 2.4 per cent
- Other Community, Social and Personal Service Activities declining by 0.5 per cent
- Fishing declining by 0.5 per cent
- Transport, Storage and Communication declining by 0.4 per cent
- Wholesale and Retail; Repair of Motor Vehicles, Motor Cycles and Personal and Household Goods declining by 0.2 per cent.

Revisions

For 2008 and 2009, data has been revised for both Current and Constant GDP as actual survey data are now available.

In 2008, the economy registered an improvement from a 0.2 percent growth to a 1.0 per cent growth.

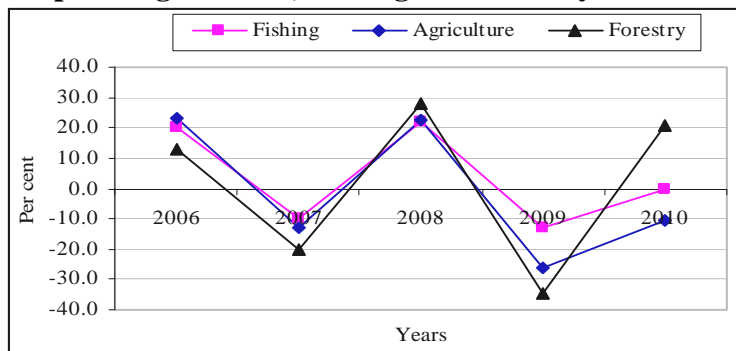
In 2009 the economy though still in the negative shows improvement from a negative 3.0 per cent (-3.0%) to a negative 1.3 per cent (-1.3%) growth (refer to Appendix 2 for revisions).

Major sectors contributing to the growth are:

- Mining and quarrying growing by 68.7 per cent
- Electricity and Water growing by 49.8 per cent
- Public Administration and Defence growing by 19.8 per cent
- Transport Storage and Communication growing by 9.3 per cent
- Health and Social Work growing by 9.1 per cent
- Hotels and Restaurant growing by 2.1 per cent

Agriculture

The decline in the growing of sugarcane, coconuts, rice, ginger, bananas, pawpaw and taro VA underpinned the decline of the agricultural sector in 2010.

Fishing

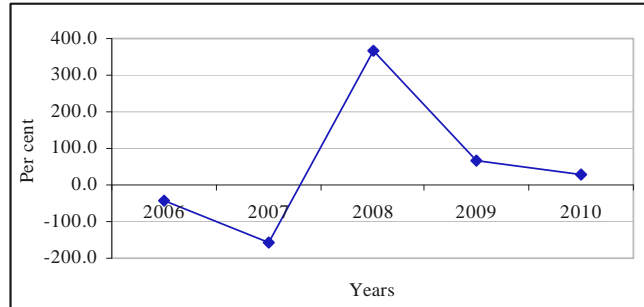
The significant decline in the operation of hatcheries and farms and seaweed farming VA underpinned the decline of the fishing sector in 2010.

Forestry

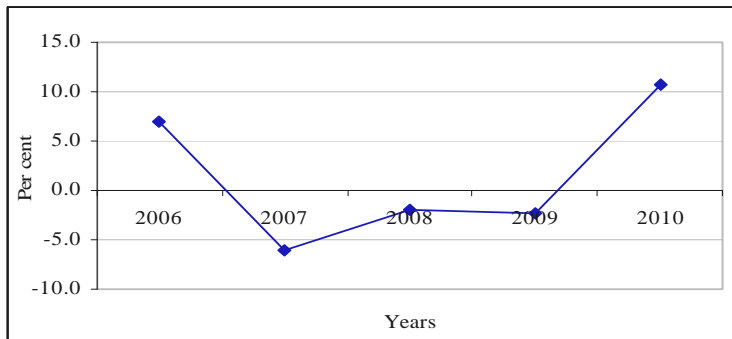
The growth in 2010 is due to the significant increase in the VA of exotic wood.

The increase in the VA of both mining and quarrying underpinned the growth in the mining and quarrying sector in 2010.



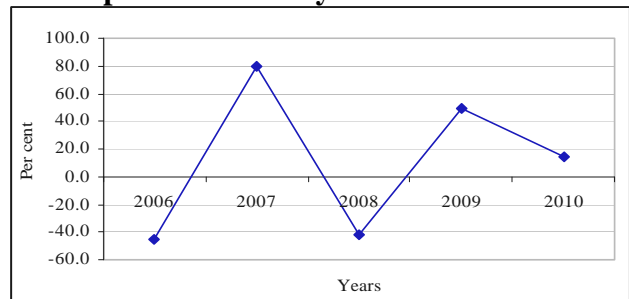
Graph 5: Manufacturing



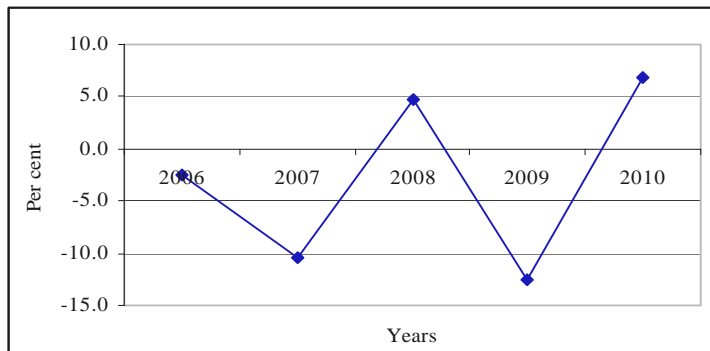
In 2010, with the exception of a few, all industries in the manufacturing sector registered growths.

Although the VA of the wholesale and retail trade; repair of motor vehicles, motor cycles and personal and household goods declined in 2010 it was an improvement compared to a bigger decline it registered in the previous two years.

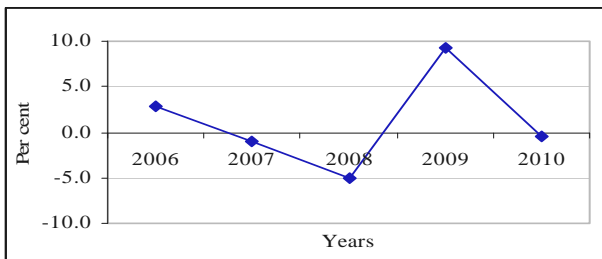
Graph 8: Distributive Trade

The decline in the VA of the transport, storage and communication sector is due to the decline in the VA of support and auxiliary transport activities and post and telecommunications in 2010.

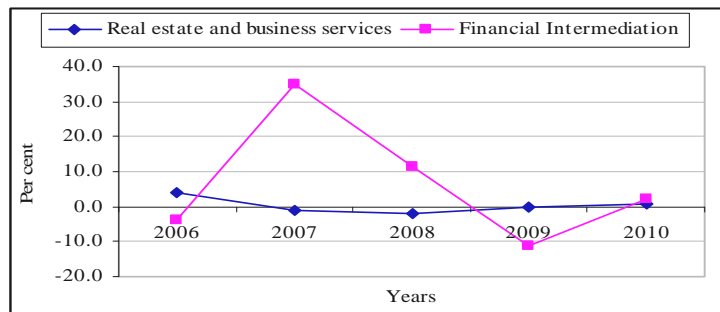
Graph 10: Real Estate and Business Services and Financial intermediations

Financial Intermediation

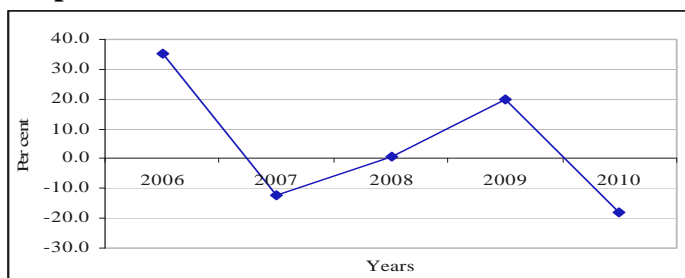
An improvement in the VA of the insurance industry contributed to the growth in the financial intermediation sector in 2010.

The VA of public administration and defence sector declined in 2010 due to decline in the VA of defence and public order and safety activities.

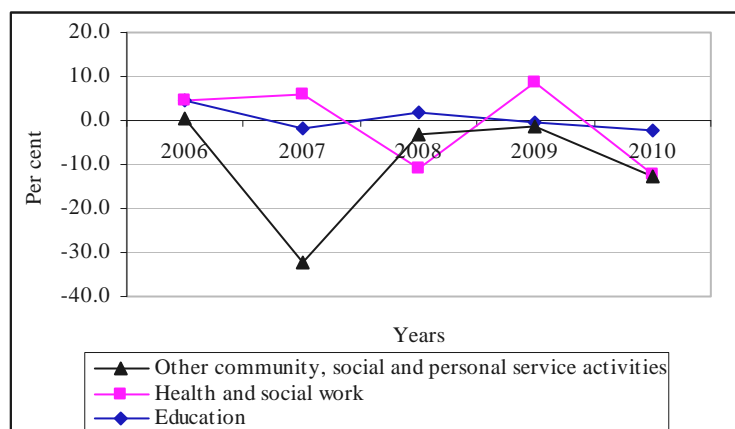
Graph 12: Education, Health and Social work and Other Community, Social and Personal service activities

Of the total GDP in 2010, the percentage of goods and services sold at economically significant prices were 79.0 per cent compared to 76.9 per cent in 2009
