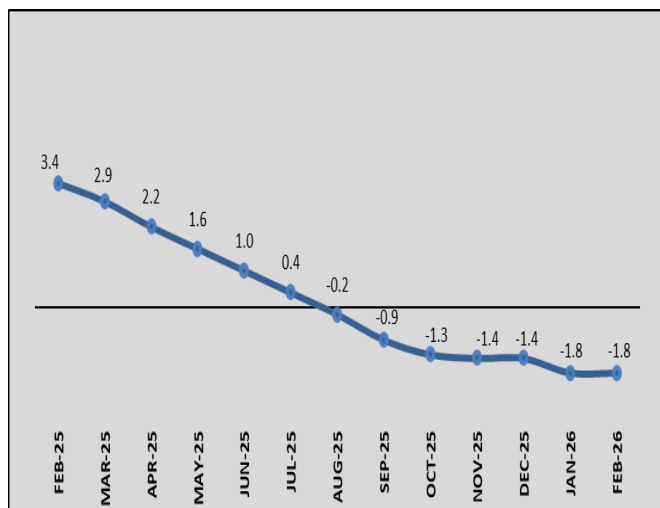
CONSUMER PRICE INDEX – FEBRUARY 2026

[Base: Average 12 months 2019 = 100.0]

The Consumer Price Index [CPI] is compiled to indicate average changes in the prices of goods and services purchased by households nationwide with monthly price collections carried out in the urban areas [Suva, Lami, Nasinu, Nausori, Lautoka, Nadi, Ba and Labasa]. The index is currently taken to represent price changes in the rural areas as well. The CPI weights are derived from the Household Income and Expenditure Survey [HIES] of 2019/2020.

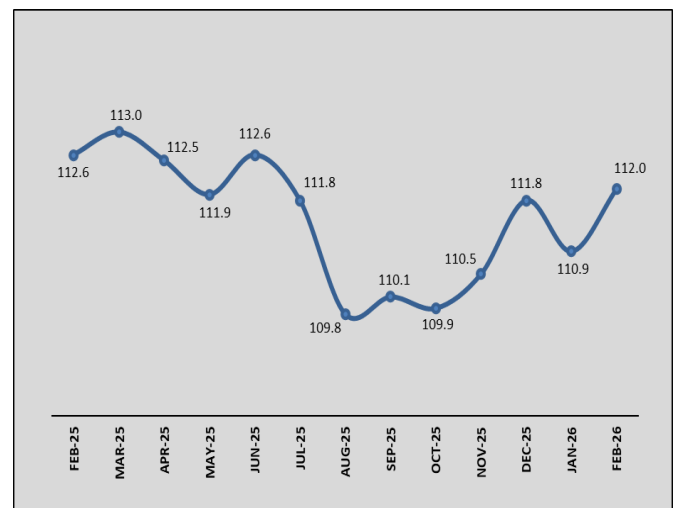
FEBRUARY 2026 highlights

Graph 1: Annual Average Inflation Rates



The average annual rate of inflation for the 12 months to February 2026 [i.e. comparing the average CPI for the 12 months from March 2025 – February 2026; with the average for the 12 months from March 2024 – February 2025] stands at -1.8 percent while the month-on-month inflation rate [compared with February 2025] stands at -0.5 percent.

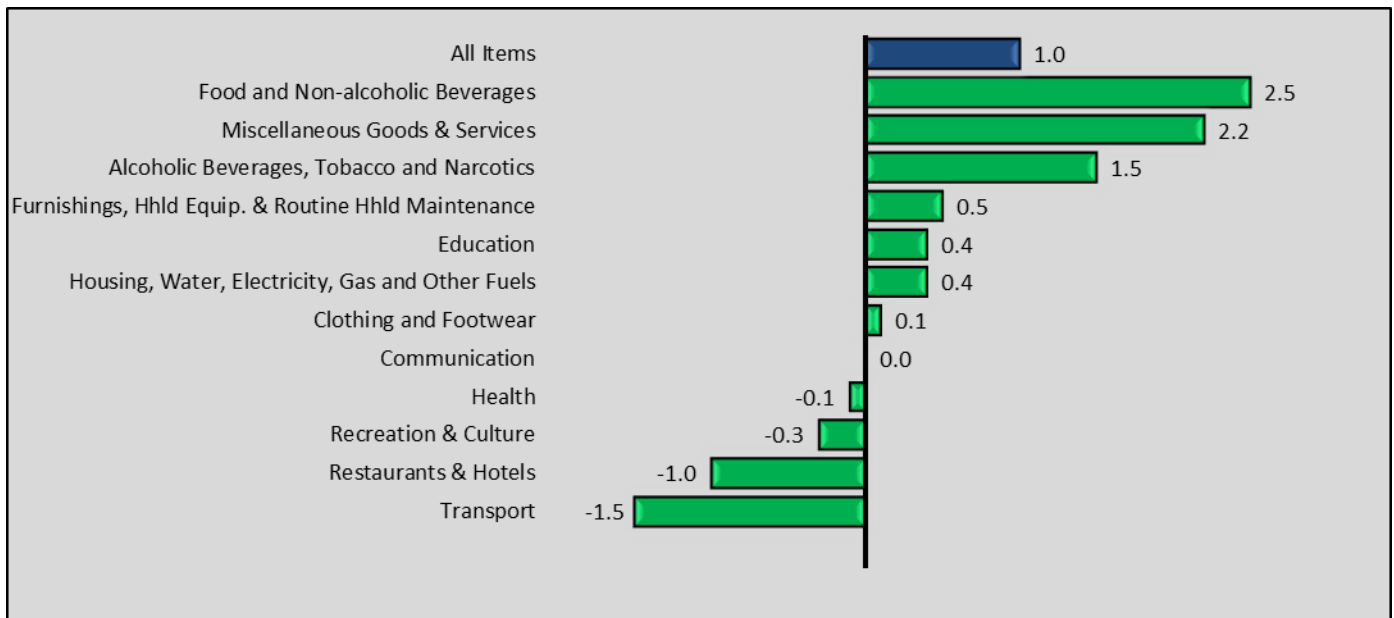
Graph 2: All Items Index



The All Items CPI for the month of February 2026 registered an increase of 1.0 percent over January 2026 [110.9] and stands at 112.0.

There are two measures of inflation used in Fiji. One compares the average CPI over the past twelve months with the average CPI over the previous twelve months while the other compares the CPI in the current month with the CPI in the comparable month of the previous year.

COICOP Divisions	% Change	Comments
Food and non – alcoholic beverages	+2.5%	Higher prices were recorded for bread & cereals, meat, fish & sea food, vegetables, confectionery, food products not elsewhere classified & non-alcoholic beverages such as coffee, tea & cocoa and mineral water, soft drinks, fruit & vegetable juices.
Miscellaneous goods and services	+2.2%	Higher prices were recorded for hairdressing salons & personal grooming establishments, other appliances, articles & products for personal care, jewellery, clocks & watches and other personal effects.
Alcoholic beverages, tobacco and narcotics	+1.5%	Higher prices were recorded for spirits, wine, beer, tobacco and yaqona.
Furnishings, household equipment and routine household maintenance	+0.5%	Higher prices were recorded for furniture & furnishings, carpets & other floor coverings, major household appliances whether electric or not, small tools & miscellaneous accessories and domestic services & household services.
Education	+0.4%	Higher prices were recorded for tertiary education.
Housing, water, electricity, gas and other fuels	+0.4%	Higher prices were recorded for gas.
Clothing and footwear	+0.1%	Higher prices were recorded for garments and other articles of clothing & accessories.
Communication	0.0%	There were price changes recorded in this division but these changes balanced out.
Health	-0.1%	Lower prices were recorded for pharmaceutical products, dental services and paramedical services.
Recreation and culture	-0.3%	Lower prices were recorded for cultural services.
Restaurants and hotels	-1.0%	Lower prices were recorded for accommodation services.
Transport	-1.5%	Lower prices were recorded for motor cars, bicycles, fuels & lubricants for personal transport equipment and passenger transport by sea & inland waterway.

Disclaimer:

Users of Consumer Price Index should exercise caution when interpreting statistics in this release relating to the Consumer Price Index and Inflation due to the non-additivity issue between the different category indexes and All Item Index. The non-additivity issue is currently being investigated by the Fiji Bureau of Statistics with support from external consultants and subject to revision in due time. Thus, proper care should be taken when using these figures.
