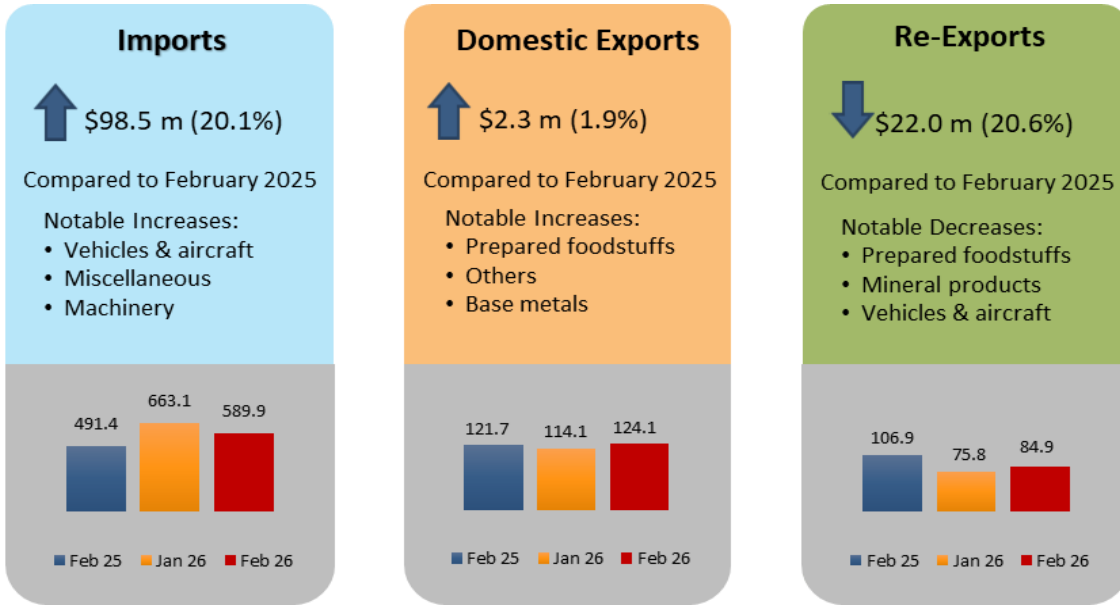

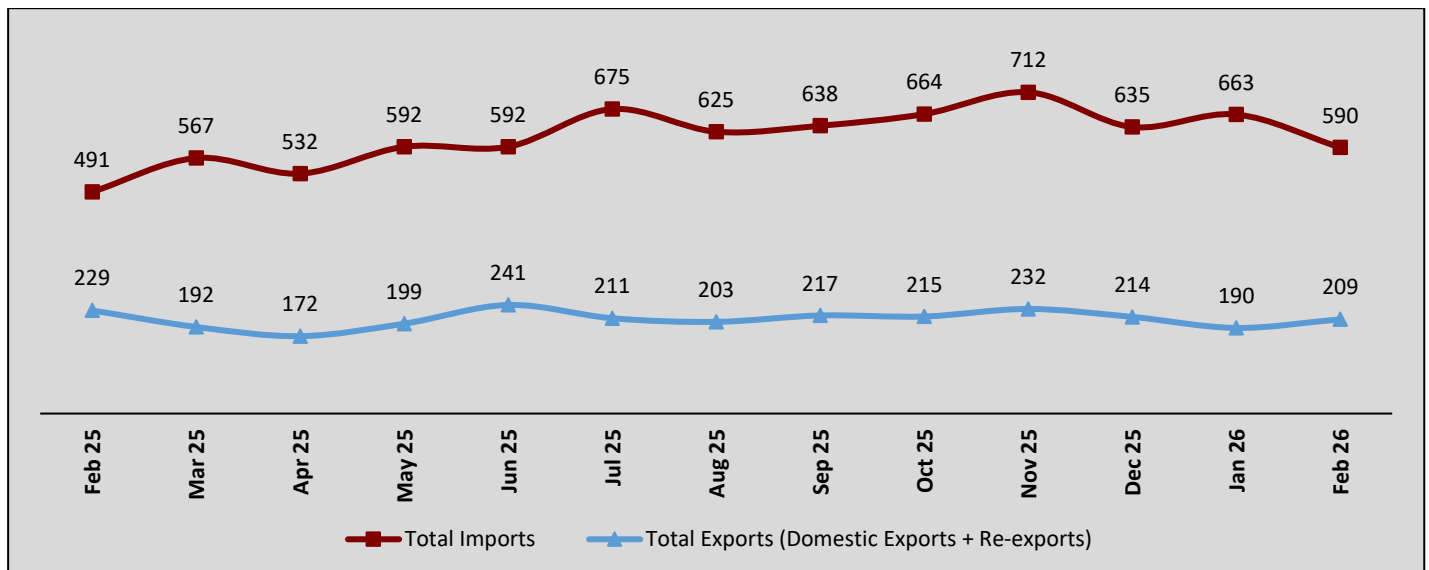
INTERNATIONAL MERCHANDISE TRADE STATISTICS February 2026

This International Merchandise Trade Statistics provides information on Fiji's exports, re-exports and imports of goods between Fiji and the rest of the world. The administrative data used to compile this release is supplied by the Fiji Revenue and Customs Service (FRCS).



Notes: The notable increases and decreases mentioned above relates to the IMTS Sections, refer to Tables 1-4. The values in the above charts are in millions and subject to rounding off.

[FJD-Millions]**

China – People’s Republic

Increased by \$69.8 million (75.6%) to \$162.1 million due to an increase in imports of:

- Modular building units, of steel;
- Ammonium sulphate; and
- Other prefabricated buildings.

Singapore

Decreased by \$7.7 million (6.8%) to \$105.7 million due to the decrease in imports of:

- Residual fuel oil;
- Other alcoholic preparations; and
- Aviation turbine fuel.

Australia

Increased by \$14.8 million (21.3%) to \$84.0 million due to an increase in imports of:

- Cruise ships & excursion boats;
- Other wheat & meslin; and
- Portable digital automatic data processing machines.

New Zealand

Increased by \$9.4 million (13.7%) to \$77.7 million due to an increase in imports of:

- Other potatoes, fresh or chilled;
- Milk in powder; and
- Stereoscopic microscopes.

Japan

Decreased by \$0.8 million (3.6%) to \$22.3 million due to the decrease in imports of:

- Used or reconditioned passenger motor cars & racing cars;
- New passenger motor cars & racing cars; and
- New motor cars & racing cars.

Illustration 2: Domestic Exports to Top 5 Major Destinations [FJD-Millions]

United States of America

Decreased by \$14.1 million (31.0%) to \$31.3 million due to the decrease in exports of:

- Mineral water;
- Kava; and
- Turmeric.

United Kingdom

Increased by \$28.4 million (2,855.0%) to \$29.4 million due to an increase in exports of:

- Sugar;
- Other ornamental fish; and
- Other wood marquetry, inlaid wood & boxes.

China – People’s Republic

Decreased by \$1.2 million (7.3%) to \$14.8 million due to the decrease in exports of:

- Beams, planks, boards & laths of raintree;
- Other beams, planks, boards, laths & the like of raintree; and
- Mineral water.

Australia

Decreased by \$5.6 million (32.6%) to \$11.6 million due to the decrease in exports of:

- Taro;
- Women’s or girls’ garments of other textile materials; and
- Other bread, pastry, cakes & biscuits.

New Zealand

Decreased by \$1.8 million (21.5%) to \$6.6 million due to the decrease in exports of:

- Other medicaments;
- Electrical conductors; and
- Biscuits (except sweet biscuits).

Illustration 3: Re-Exports to Top 5 Major Destinations [FJD-Millions]

Tonga

Decreased by \$2.2 million (20.2%) to \$8.7 million due to the decrease in re-exports of:

- Light oils & preparations;
- Gas-oil (diesel); and
- Milk for infant use.

United States of America

Increased by \$0.8 million (22.1%) to \$4.3 million due to an increase in re-exports of:

- Provision for aircraft or ships' stores;
- Other parts of airplanes, helicopters or unmanned aircraft; and
- Fresh fish (tuna).

Cook Islands

Decreased by \$1.8 million (36.8%) to \$3.0 million due to the decrease in re-exports of:

- Gas-oil (diesel);
- Light oils & preparations; and
- Other crude oil.

New Zealand

Increased by \$0.04 million (1.6%) to \$2.8 million due to an increase in re-exports of:

- Other women's or girls' garments of other textile materials;
- Other beauty or make-up preparations; and
- Men's or boys' jacket & blazers of cotton.

Wallis & Futuna

Increased by \$0.5 million (23.5%) to \$2.6 million due to an increase in re-exports of:

- Lubricating oils & mineral turpentine;
- Gas-oil (diesel); and
- Other smoking tobacco.
