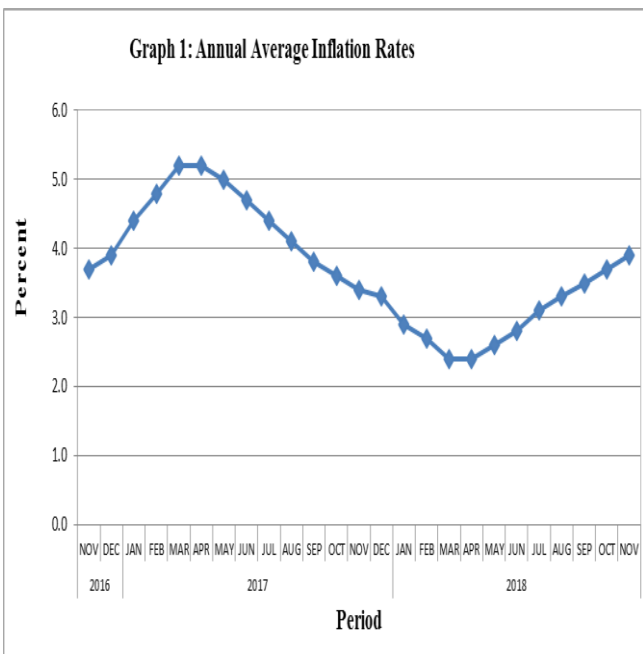

CONSUMER PRICE INDEX – NOVEMBER 2018

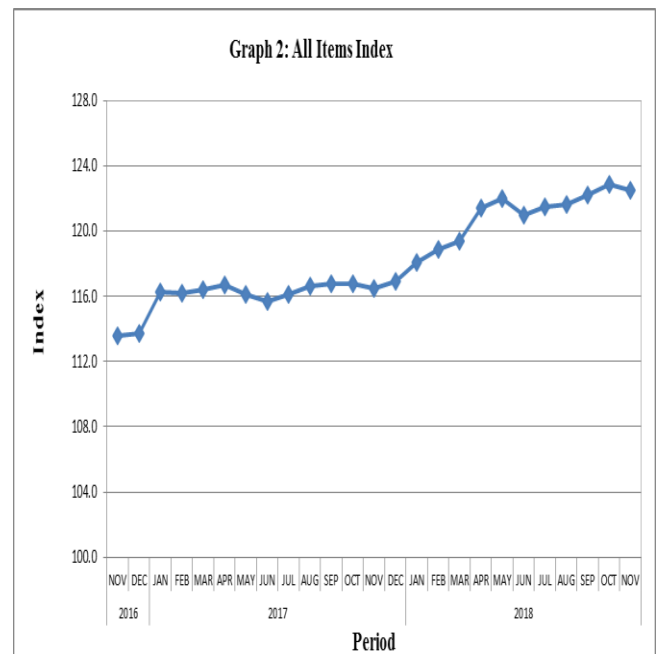
[Base: Average 12 months 2011 = 100.0]

The Consumer Price Index [CPI] is compiled to indicate average changes in the prices of goods and services purchased by households nationwide with monthly price collections carried out in the urban areas [Suva, Lami, Nasinu, Nausori, Lautoka, Nadi, Ba and Labasa]. The index is currently taken to represent price changes in the rural areas as well. The CPI weights are derived from the Household Income and Expenditure Survey [HIES] of 2008/2009.

November 2018 Highlights



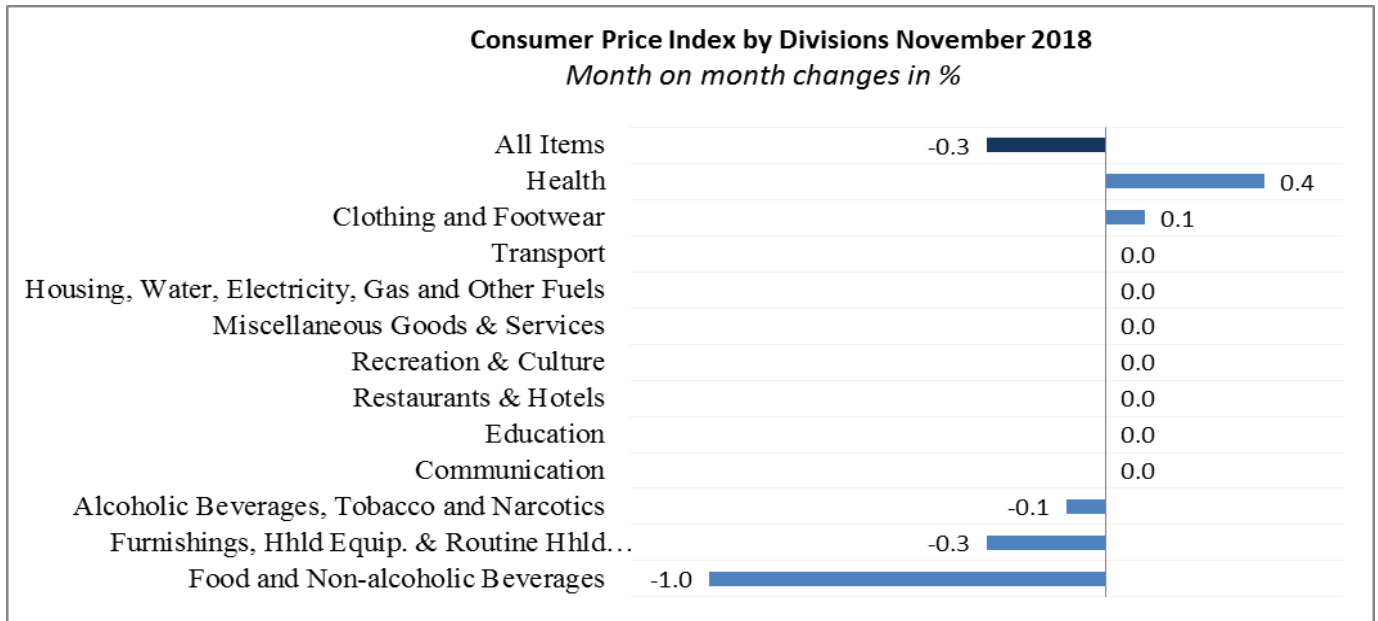
The average annual rate of inflation for the twelve months to November 2018 [i.e. comparing the average CPI for the 12 months from December 2017 – November 2018; with the average for the 12 months from December 2016 – November 2017] stands at 3.9 percent while the month- on- month inflation rate [compared with November 2017] stands at 5.2 percent.



The All Items CPI for the month of November registered a decrease of 0.3 percent over October 2018 [122.9] and stands at 122.5.

There are two measures of inflation used in Fiji. One compares the average CPI over the past twelve months with the average CPI over the previous twelve months while the other compares the CPI in the current month with the CPI in the comparable month of the previous year.

Details of price changes between October 2018 and November 2018 by expenditure class are as follows:



FOOD AND NON-ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES: -1.0%

Lower prices were recorded for bread & cereals, meat, fish & sea food, milk, cheese & eggs, fruit, vegetables, sugar, jam, honey, chocolate & confectionery, food products not elsewhere classified.

ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES, TOBACCO AND NARCOTICS: -0.1%

Lower prices were recorded for wine and yaqona.

CLOTHING AND FOOTWEAR: +0.1%

Higher prices were recorded for shoes & other footwear.

HOUSING, WATER, ELECTRICITY, GAS AND OTHER FUELS: 0.0%

No price changes were recorded in this division.

FURNISHINGS, HOUSEHOLD EQUIPMENT AND ROUTINE HOUSEHOLD MAINTENANCE: -0.3%

Lower prices were recorded for household textiles, small tools & miscellaneous accessories and non-durable household goods.

HEALTH: +0.4%

Higher prices were recorded for pharmaceutical products.

TRANSPORT: 0.0%

There were some price changes recorded in this division but these changes balanced out.

COMMUNICATION: 0.0%

There were some price changes recorded in this division but these changes balanced out.

RECREATION AND CULTURE: 0.0%

There were some price changes recorded in this division but these changes balanced out.

EDUCATION: 0.0%

No price changes were recorded in this division.

RESTAURANTS AND HOTELS: 0.0%

No price changes were recorded in this division.

MISCELLANEOUS GOODS AND SERVICES: 0.0%


